

Criteria for abstracts	Do you have this information to include in your abstract?	I am/ We are ready!
Basis of inquiry/intro— Is there a hook?	You identify the problem and rationale for this direction/approach	
Purpose/objective/aim— Do these jump out?	You clearly state the purpose/objectives/aims Hint: this needs to be a sentence that jumps out at the reader	
Methods— What, who, how?	<p>You clearly state how you did your project and these should relate to the purpose/objective</p> <p><b>If research project:</b> you describe design, sample, how you measured outcomes, if there was an intervention, what it was, and how you analyzed results</p> <p><b>If QI/EBP project:</b> you explain what you did to change a system (the intervention) and how you measured outcomes</p> <p><b>If educational project:</b> you describe the educational intervention, who was focus of intervention, and how learner outcomes were measured</p>	
Findings/Outcomes— What did you find? What does it mean?	<p>You logically and concisely state the findings/outcomes and relate them to the objectives/aims and methods</p> <p><b>If research:</b> Present summary results (outcomes) and comment on how this may influence nursing practice.</p> <p><b>If Quality Improvement:</b> Present outcomes of project and implications for practice</p> <p><b>If Practice or Education program evaluation:</b> Summarize outcomes of the educational program</p>	
Content Relevance	You clearly show why this matters to developmental health
